David Bruchez-Lalli is an internationally acclaimed Swiss musician, recognized for his excellence as a conductor, trombonist, and educator. As **Conductor of the Zurich Youth Symphony Orchestra** and **Principal Trombonist of the Tonhalle Orchestra Zurich**, he has played a pivotal role in shaping the classical music landscape through performance, teaching, and leadership.

## 2. Biography

### Conducting Career

**David Bruchez-Lalli has established himself as an accomplished conductor, dedicated to both professional and educational ensembles.**

- **Since 2015:** Chief Conductor of the **Zurich Youth Symphony Orchestra**.
- Led international tours in **South Korea, Spain, Portugal, Finland, the UK, the Baltic states, Bratislava, Ljubljana, Prague, and Budapest**.
- **Since 2010:** Conducts the **Tonhalle Orchestra Zurich** for family concerts and educational projects, bringing orchestral music to new audiences.
- Notable productions include:
  - *Peter and the Wolf* (Prokofiev)
  - *The Carnival of the Animals* (Saint-Saëns)
  - *The Nutcracker* (Tchaikovsky)
  - *The Young Person's Guide to the Orchestra* (Britten)
- **2025:** Conducting concerts at **Vienna Konzerthaus, Dortmund, Laeiszhalle Hamburg, Isar Philharmonie, KKL Luzern, Basel, and Bern**.
- **13 September 2025:** Conducting world premieres of works by **Richard Dubugnon** and **Daniel Schnyder** for the **50th anniversary of the Swiss Youth Music Competition** in Zurich.

### Teaching & Pedagogy

A dedicated educator, Bruchez-Lalli has shaped the next generation of musicians through his teaching and masterclasses.

- **Professor at the Zurich University of the Arts (ZHdK) since 2008.**
- Former professor at:
  - **Detmold Hochschule für Musik (2005–2010).**
  - **Lausanne Conservatory (1998–2003).**
- Masterclasses in **Italy, Portugal, Spain, France, Estonia, Russia, Ukraine, Germany.**
- Passionate about orchestral training, particularly for wind ensembles and symphony orchestras.

## Education and Early Career

- Selected for a tour with the **World Youth Orchestra** at age 17.
- 1995: Awarded a scholarship to the **Herbert von Karajan Academy** of the **Berlin Philharmonic**, a milestone that allowed him to perform at the **Berlin Philharmonic** under legendary conductors such as: Claudio Abbado, Bernard Haitink, Seiji Ozawa, Sir Simon Rattle, James Levine, Sir George Solti.
- 1996: Joined the **Zurich Opera Orchestra**.
- **Since 2005: Principal Trombonist of the Tonhalle Orchestra Zurich.**
